Required Pre-Physician Assistant Course Work

All prerequisite courses must be taken for a grade, rather than pass/no pass. The courses required for admission to most physician assistant programs are listed below. Consult the web sites or catalogs of the schools to which you plan to apply to determine each school's specific requirements.

PLEASE NOTE: The AAPA is in the process of implementing a new entrance exam for PA programs called the PA-CAT. This test will mimic the MCAT in many ways with slight variations. This test covers Anatomy, Physiology, General Biology, Microbiology, Genetics, General Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Biochemistry, Behavioral Sciences, and Statistics. This guide will be updated to reflect PA-CAT content as the exam becomes standardized.

Health Care Experience

A unique component of the PA school pre-requisites is the requirement of direct patient care experience. OHSU requires 2,000 hours minimum prior to application and Pacific requires 1,000 hours minimum at the time of application to their PA program. There are many ways to gain this experience and both OHSU and Pacific list examples through their PA program webpages. If you are ever unsure if an experience will count towards these hours, contact the schools you are interested in as soon as possible to get approval. Please note that many applicants have well over the minimum hours required when applying to PA programs.

Additional Information

The sample course requirements above are directed towards the OHSU and Pacific PA programs but fulfill most PA program pre-requisite requirements. More information on PA schools can be found at the American Academy of Physician Assistants (AAPA) and at the Central Application Service for Physician Assistants (CASPA). Students are encouraged to consult these resources early in their pre-PA preparation. Information may also be obtained from the Health Professions Advisors.
