Observation Experience:

Pacific University's DPT program recommends 100 hours minimum of paid or volunteer experience with a current, practicing, certified physical therapist. This must be done prior to application. Consult other schools for their specific observation experience requirements and/or recommendations.

Additional Information

Profiles of individual PT schools can be found online. Accredited programs are listed on the American Physical Therapy Association website along with other helpful application information.

In selecting schools to which to apply, pay particular attention to particular degree options as they vary with the PT degree (DTP, MPT, MSPT, MS). Also look at non-resident acceptance rates, total number of applicants, average GPA/GRE of admitted applicants, additional pre-PT requirements, special programs or curricula, tuition cost, and location.
