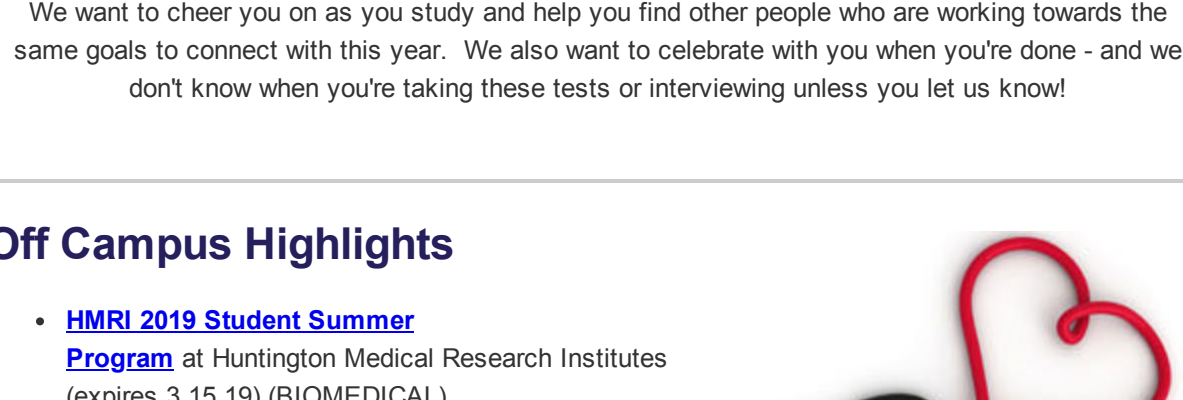

Are you Taking an Entrance Exam or Interviewing This Year?!

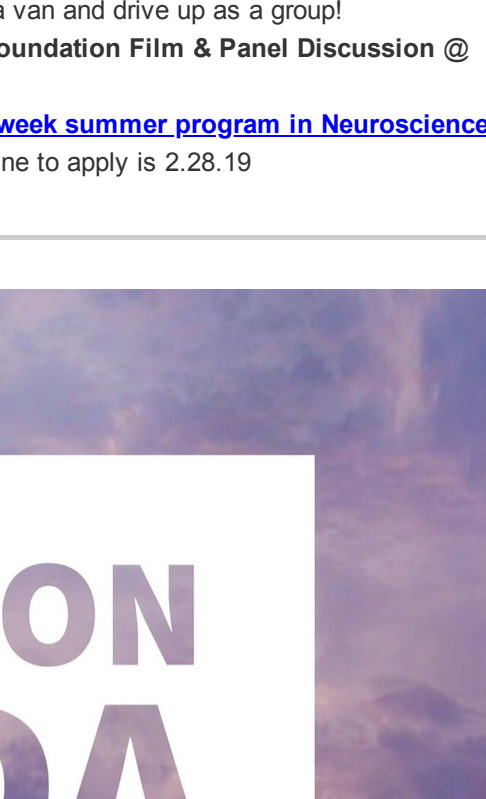
MCAT? DAT? GRE? PCAT? OAT?

OPEN YOUR HEART TO THE POSSIBILITIES

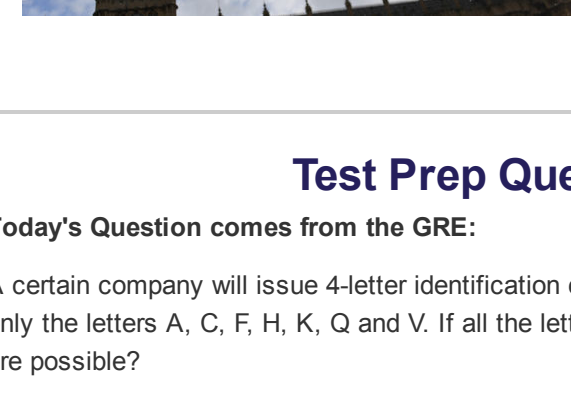

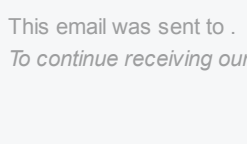
