### AAMC Fee Assistance Program Reminder: Benefits are Not Retroactive

It's important to ensure you apply to the AAMC Fee Assistance Program before registering for the MCAT exam or submitting your AMCAS application. If you are awarded fee assistance program benefits, you cannot apply the benefits to previous registrations or purchases. For example, if you register for the MCAT exam or purchase an MCAT prep product before receiving fee assistance, you will not be reimbursed for the discounted rate. Similarly, you cannot use awarded medical school designations if your AMCAS application was submitted before your Fee Assistance Program application was approved.
