A dance drama with live music by UP faculty and alumni

An aging mother's health teeters on the brink. Her adult daughter scrambles to find footing as her role shifts from child to authority figure. Death pounds at the door and they both wonder, could someone this pissed off actually be dying? Through an interdisciplinary blend of music, movement and theatrical storytelling, "The Undertaking" uses actor/dancers to portray the end-of-life care of an elder using Dmitri Shostakovich's Piano Trio No. 2, played live by local music ensemble Northwest Piano Trio.
